## Which Way to Adventure?

- J/Fiction Gutman **Genius Files** by Dan Gutman 293 pages  
On a cross-country vacation with their parents, twins Coke and Pepsi, soon to be thirteen, fend off strange assassins as they try to come to terms with their being part of a top-secret government organization known as The Genius Files.
- J/Fiction Mull **Fablehaven** by Brandon Mull 351 pages  
When Kendra and Seth go to stay at their grandparents' estate, they discover that it is a sanctuary for magical creatures and that a battle between good and evil is looming.
- J/Fiction Stilton **Lost Treasure of the Emerald Eye** by Geronimo Stilton 116 pages  
When Geronimo's sister, Thea, discovers an old, mysterious map showing a secret treasure hidden on a faraway island, the gang of the "Rodent's Gazette" is dragged into a treasure hunt. (First in a series.)
- J/Fiction Thirty Nine **Maze of Bones** by Rick Riordan 220 pages  
At the reading of their grandmother's will, Dan and Amy Cahill are given the choice of receiving a million dollars or uncovering the 39 clues hidden around the world that will lead to the source of the family's power, but by taking on the clues, they end up in a dangerous race against their own family members. (First in the series.)
- J/GN Kibuishi **Copper** by Kazu Kibuishi 94 pages  
Copper is curious, and Fred is fearful — together boy and dog are off on a series of adventures powered by Copper's limitless imagination. The two friends have a knack for getting into all sorts of odd situations, but Copper's good cheer always smoothes the way--and Fred can usually be won over if there's food involved.
- J/GN Missile Mouse **Missile Mouse: the Star Crusher** 172 pages  
Missile Mouse, a secret agent for the Galactic Security Agency, battles deadly foes in order to rescue a scientist from the Rogue Imperium of Planets, which is trying to steal a doomsday machine capable of destroying the universe.
- J Chapter/Choose **Choose your own Adventure (series)**  
You are the adventurer as you decide the outcome of these books!
- J Chapter/Hunt **Secret Agent Jack Stalwart (series)**  
Jack is an ordinary kid who becomes a secret agent by night, thwarting evil all over the world as he searches for his missing brother, Max.
