

Juvenile Humorous Fiction Youth Services

- J/Fiction Cossanteli ***The Extincts*** by Veronica Cossanteli 230 pages
In order to raise money for a new bicycle, George takes a job at Wormestall Farm, where he encounters creatures supposedly extinct or mythological, a new--female--friend, and a maniacal taxidermist who wants the animals for her own collection.
- J/Fiction Fischer ***This is Not the Abby Show*** by Debbie Fischer 311 pages
A girl with ADHD loves to make people laugh, but when her acting out gets her stuck in summer school, she will have to try her hardest to turn over a new leaf.
- J/Fiction Guys ***Funny Business*** 268 pages
A collection of humorous stories featuring a teenage mummy, a homicidal turkey, and the world's largest pool of chocolate milk.
- J/Fiction Holm ***Middle School is Worse than Meatloaf*** by Jennifer Holm 128 pages
Ginny starts out with ten items on her to-do list for seventh grade, but notes, cartoons, and other "stuff" reveal what seems like a thousand things that go wrong between September and June, both at school and at home.
- J/Fiction Kurtz ***The Pup Who Cried Wolf*** by Chris Kurtz 132 pages
A Chihuahua from New York City who feels he is truly a wolf in an undersized body, goes to Yellowstone National Park with dreams of running wild with his wolf brothers.
- J/Fiction Lewis ***Super Chicken Nugget Boy and the Furious Fry*** by Josh Lewis 141 pages
After he falls into a pool of radioactive green goo behind Bogie's Burger Barn, nerdy Fern Goldberg develops super-hero skills when his skin comes into contact with condiments-- a talent which helps him take on villains great and small. Look for other *Super Chicken Nugget Boy* books by this author.
- J/Fiction Levy ***The Misadventures of the Family Fletcher*** by Dana Alison Levy 260 pages
Relates the adventures of a family with two fathers, four adopted boys, and a variety of pets as they make their way through a school year and deal with a grumpy new neighbor.
- J/Fiction Meyerhoff ***Class B.U.R.P*** by Jenny Meyerhoff 282 pages
After a video of ten-year-old Louie Burger is aired on a comedy television show, Louie hopes that he will no longer be a Boy Used to Ridicule and Put-downs (B.U.R.P.), but his popularity is very short-lived.

- J/Fiction Pichon ***The Brilliant World of Tom Gates*** by Liz Pichon 238 pages
Irritating his teachers with his lack of focus and creative excuses, Tom Gates spends his time drawing pictures and writing down observations about everything from his grumpy sister and annoying classmate to an unsatisfying camping trip.
- J/Chapter Vande Velde ***8 Class Pets+One Squirrel Divided by One Dog=Chaos*** by Vivian Vande Velde 68 pages
A dog chases a squirrel into an elementary school one night, creating monumental chaos.

- J/Fiction Barnett ***The Terrible Two*** by Mac Barnett 215 pages
When master prankster Miles Murphy moves to sleepy Yawnee Valley, he challenges the local mystery prankster in an epic battle of tricks, but soon the two join forces to pull off the biggest prank ever seen.
- J/Fiction Barry ***The Worst Class Trip Ever*** by Dave Barry 214 pages
When an eighth grade civics class goes on a trip to Washington, D.C., Wyatt Palmer finds himself in deep trouble before the plane even lands because his best friend Matt's decided the men sitting behind them are terrorists--and it's up to the boys to stop them.
- J/Fiction Buckley ***National Espionage, Rescue, and Defense Society*** by Michael Buckley 306 pages
While running a spy network from their elementary school, five unpopular misfits combine their talents and use cutting-edge gadgetry to fight evil around the world.
- J/Fiction Sachar ***Sideways Stories from Wayside School*** by Louis Sachar 118 pages
Presents humorous episodes from the classroom on the thirtieth floor of Wayside School, which was accidentally built sideways with one classroom on each story. Book 1 in the *Wayside School* series.
- J/Fiction Patterson ***How I Survived Bullies, Broccoli, and Snake Hill*** by James Patterson 309 pages
When Rafe Khatchadorian is sent to Camp Wanamorra, he teams up with his bunk mates to find out the more "popular" kids' plans to ruin their summer. The fourth book in the *Middle School* series.
- J/Fiction Trine ***The Curse of the Bologna Sandwich*** by Greg Trine 138 pages
After graduating from the superhero academy, Melvin Beederman heads for Los Angeles, where he unexpectedly teams up with Candace Brinkwater, school play actress, to nab the evil McNasty Brothers.
- J/Fiction Vail ***Justin Case: School, Drool, and Other Daily Disasters*** by Rachel Vail 245 pages
Relates the daily worries and problems of Justin Case as he struggles to survive third grade.
