While running a spy network from their elementary school, five unpopular misfits combine their talents and use cutting-edge gadgetry to fight evil around the world.

Collins ***Gregor the Overlander*** by Suzanne Collins 311 pages  
When eleven-year-old Gregor and his two-year-old sister are pulled into a strange world, they trigger an epic battle involving men, bats, rats, cockroaches, and spiders.

Cottrell-Boyce ***Cosmic*** by Frank Cottrell-Boyce 313 pages
